Information regarding holidays with dogs

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen!

We are very pleased that you have decided to spend your holiday with your "best friend" - your dog - in our community Annaberg-Lungötz.

To prevent misunderstandings we would like to inform you as follows:

In the whole local community Annaberg-Lungötz is a regulation for dogs: You have a leash to use and you have to collect the excrement of your dog. The documents can be found on our homepage www.annaberg-lungoetz.at (Gemeinde – Aktuelles u. Verordnungen).

Excrement from your dog on graslands and field paths is problematic because on these agricultural lands the food for our cows an sheeps grows and this is the basis for high-quality food (milk and meat) for every person.

The animals/cattles have problems with the dirty food. For example, if cattle absorb the excrement from the dog by food, metabolic diseases can even be the result of abortion until they die. Among other things, the infectious disease "Neosporose" can be transmitted by the dog-exrements, it leads in pregnant cattle to the death of the unborn calf in the womb. The pathogens of the disease can last up to two years on the area.



Many dog owners use very exemplary the "sacks for the feaces" (in german "Gackisackerl") provided by the community. However, this also means that these plastic bags are not disposed of in nature, on roadsides or fields after use, please dispose it in trashcan or containers. Filled "Gackisackerl" are in the blazing sun not only ticking stink bombs, the plastic in the cattle stomachs can mean a torturous death for the animals

When walking with the dog, it is advisable to follow simple rules. Conflicts can be avoided in advance.

- Objects thrown into grasslands and fields to play with the dog can cause considerable damage to the agricultural machinery.
 - Agricultural land is no run-off area!
 - Please collect the dog waste of your four-legged friend!
 - Please dispose of the "Gackisackerl" in the trashcans or containers and not in nature!
 - Please keep your dog on a leash to protect the animals! Often, poultry are chased and killed by free-range dogs. Sheep and goats are often terrified in there areas such as alpine-pastures. Cattle and horses are in panic, break out of the fences or injure themselves. Even our wild animals will thank you.
